### **SACRAMENTO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (SMF):**

SMF is located 12 miles northwest of downtown Sacramento. SuperShuttle is the provider for all on-call sedan service (1-800-258-3826). Round-trip taxi between the airport and downtown is approximately \$50.00; one-way between the airport and downtown is approximately \$27.00.

### **DRIVING DIRECTIONS:**

Coming from any direction in state, take Interstate 5 to the J Street exit and follow the signs into the "Old Sacramento" district.

### **TRAIN:**

The Sacramento Amtrak Station is located at 401 I Street, adjacent to Old Sacramento and within walking distance. Visit the Amtrak website for more information.

### **BOAT DOCKS:**

The Old Sacramento Boat Docks are available for daily and overnight use. For more information please contact the City of Sacramento at (916)808-7031.

### **PARKING:**

Valet parking through the Delta King for non-stateroom guests is \$10.00 per car for up to 5 hours, \$2.00 for each additional hour after 5 hours up to \$18.00. Valet parking is offered on a space-available basis. \$18.00 for hotel overnight guests.

Covered parking is available in two parking structures located at either end of Old Sacramento. Many Old Sacramento businesses will validate parking for these parking garages, be sure to ask the waitperson or store clerk about parking validations at the end of your transaction.

In addition, a surface parking lot is located at Front & L Streets (enter from L Street at Firehouse Alley).
